300.106 Extended School Year Services – Each public agency must ensure that extended school year services are available as necessary to provide FAPE, consistent with paragraph (a)(2) Extended school year services must be provided only if a child’s IEP Team determines, on an individual basis, in accordance with 300.320 through 300.324, that the services are necessary for the provision of FAPE to the child.
